Subject: Disposal of damaged foodgrains by the FCI - Changes in the procedure.

Ref: This office letter No. QC.9(DFG)/Policy/2003/Vol.IA dated 2.03.2006

Sir,

This is in continuation to this office letter dated 2.03.2006 on the subject cited wherein instructions for disposal of damaged foodgrains in FCI were circulated by the Headquarters.

In this regard, it is to inform that these instructions have been reviewed and the following amendments in the Para 5 of Hqrs. letter dated 2.03.2006 under reference, are made and the same shall strictly be followed with immediate effect.

Existing provisions in Para No. 5	Amendment in Para No. 5
It is reiterated that wherever, the rates of damaged foodgrains received in tender enquiry/auction are below the reserve price, such rates shall invariably be approved by the next higher authority i.e. Executive Director (Zone).	Executive Director (Zone) shall be the Competent Authority for disposal of such damaged foodgrains stocks for which either the bids are not received even after two successive Tenders/Auction or received below reserve prices. <u>In the extreme situation that no bid is received in two successive tenders/auction(only once for stocks "fit for Manure"), dumping of such stocks shall invariably be approved by the Executive Director(Zone).</u> After getting due approval from ED(Zone), General Manager(Region) shall arrange disposal of the said quantity of damaged foodgrains accordingly.

There is no other changes in the existing instructions issued vide Hqrs. letter No. QC.9(DFG)/Policy/2003/Vol.IA dated 2.03.2006. These instructions may be brought to the knowledge of all concerned, for strict compliance under intimation to Hqrs.
