Subject: Relaxation in specification of Lustre loss wheat for Government of Haryana -reg.
Sir,

I am directed to refer your D.O. letter No. SS/ACSF&S/433 dated 22.04.2019 & D.O. No. SS/ACSF&S/503 dt. 25.04.2019 wherein the analysis results of samples drawn from various districts of Haryana by FCI in association with State Government were sent, seeking relaxation in specification of wheat for RMS 2019-20 due to unseasonal rainfall in various districts of Haryana.

In order to reduce the hardship of farmers and to avoid distress sale of wheat, by them Government of India had allowed to procure wheat in various affected districts of Haryana by allowing relaxation in Lustre loss wheat on provisional basis based on the assessment report of FCI so that farmers should get the remunerative price of their produce, vide Department of Food & Public Distribution letter of even No. dated 26.04.2019.

Now, based on analysis results of wheat samples collected & analysed by the Joint team comprising of officers of Ministry, FCI & State Government of Haryana same relaxation granted earlier are being continued and are to be treated as **Final**. Other terms & conditions will remain the same.
