**विषय:-** Guideline to curb recycling of Rice during KMS 2018-19.

Sir,

Please refer to the communication under reference on the subject cited vide which, Ministry of Food has requested all the Principal Secretary/Secretary(Food) to take steps to stop malpractice by unscrupulous Rice Millers in recycling of PDS rice stocks. You may be well aware that recycling of PDS foodgrains in procurement operation is a serious menace and requires immediate arrest. FCI Field functionaries are therefore required to keep a strict vigil at the time of procurement of rice from the State Agencies/Millers. Following are some precautionary guidelines to detect recycling which may be kept in mind by the field functionaries, while doing procurement operations in order to detect recycling:

1. If millers are tendering huge quantity of rice beyond their milling capacity.
2. If condition of gunnies is old or second hand or rice is packed in gunnies by reversing the gunnies.
3. If the presence of infestations/dead or alive insects in the rice is noticed.
4. If the consignment contains encrusted grains or emit musty smell or have appreciable quantity of loose bran.
5. If gunnies bear different color stenciling, double stenciling/ overlapping of stenciling, use of different color of stitches than the color code of current season, with different mill names (or) presence of ACK numbers (or) portion of left over threads (or) stitching marks on the mouths of bags, are noticed.
6. In case, there are cases of missing rexin flap/other mills rexin flaps/double contact numbers.

7. When millers who are always offering boiled rice only, are offering raw rice or vice versa.
8. When the moisture content is abnormally low.
9. When the delivery of rice in a particular Revenue district is more than the production of paddy in terms of rice.
10. Delivery of rice of some different variety, which are generally not grown in that Revenue District/State.
11. When different other varieties of Rice are mixed with the principal variety.
12. Mixture of broken of Gr.-A variety with common rice (or) vice versa.

To prevent recycling, field functionaries may take following actions;

- a) Bags may be selected on random basis and reversed while accepting the stocks to see for the presence of any webbing.
- b) Immediately on completion of paddy procurement season, State Agencies should be asked to declare Revenue District-wise procurement of paddy and intimate to FCI.
- c) Prior intimation to FCI on shifting/transfer of paddy from one Revenue district to another district be insisted upon.
- d) Own local intelligence by staff about the miller who brings rice from outside be utilized.
- e) It should be ensured that the freshly procured rice stocks is issued /despatched only after super check by next higher authority as instructed vide this office letter no. QC.2(1)/KMS/2018-19 Dated. 12.09.2018.

Area Manager and AGM(QC) would be responsible to check incidence of recycling of the rice stocks in FCI depots and they will caution the field functionaries to take all corrective measures. Strict action should be taken against the Millers who deliver the recycled rice besides taking disciplinary action against staff, who procured recycled stocks. Any incidence of recycling of Rice be brought to the notice of the concerned State Authorities in writing for immediate remedial action. Besides this, the instructions/guidelines issued by FCI/Ministry in this regard be followed in true spirit.
