OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT:- HOLDING OF MINIMUM STOCKS LEVEL (MSL) BY FCI DEPOTS FOR DEFENCE.

In pursuance of discussions between Defence Ministry and Feed Corporation of India (HQrs) for assured reserve stocks of wheat and rice, the stations have been identified in consultation with FCI in which FCI Depots would hold Minimum Stocks Level (MSL) of quantities of wheat & rice as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively. This would cater for assured supply unforeseen eventualities.

2. The stock of wheat and rice held by FCI depots would continue to be the property of FCI. For draws of stock from Minimum Stock Level (MSL), Army HQrs will have to request FCI HQrs who in turn would issue instructions to their respective depots for supply of goods to the SD of Army HQrs. FCI Depots would regularly maintain the MSL but bending of stocks for Defence will not be necessary. If change is required from one FCI depot to another on account of exigencies, the MSL at alternate FCI Depot would be made available by FCI at the 6 weeks notice of Defence Ministry.

3. An annual review for holding of MSL stocks should be held in Defence Ministry (APO) in consultation with FCI HQrs. At district level a physical check of MSL holding would be carried out once in every quarter by the local representative of Army HQrs in consultation with District Manager, FCI.

4. The system of holding of Minimum Stock Level (MSL) by FCI would come into effect from 1.1.1993.

5. FCI HQrs are requested to disseminate the similar instructions to their channels for compliance.



HOLDING OF MINIMUM STOCKS LEVEL (MSL) BY
FCI DEPOTS FOR DEFENCE

1. Reference APO letter No J-11012/2/92-Pur I dated 23 Sep 92 (Copy attached).
2. In pursuance to the discussions between Army HQ, Defence Ministry and Food Corporation of India (HQrs), New Delhi, it has been decided that minimum stock level of rice and wheat will be kept by FCI at various depots for requirement by the Defence. This has been worked out based on our two months requirements. Details of stations identified and quantities is att at Appendices 'A' & 'B'.
3. The stock of wheat and rice held by FCI depots would continue to be the property of FCI. For drawals of stocks from Minimum Stock Level (MSL), this HQ will have to request FCI Hqrs who in turn would issue instructions to their respective depots for supply of goods to the respective Sup Deps. FCI Depots would regularly maintain the MSL but binding of stocks for Defence will not be necessary. In case stocks are required at FCI depots other than those nominated, the same can be arranged by the FCI HQrs with a notice of six weeks.
4. A Physical check of MSL holding would be carried out once in every quarter by you through a Board of Officers in consultation with District Manager, FCI. Details of such checkings may be intimated to this HQ.
5. The system of holding of Minimum stock Level (MSL) by FCI would come into effect from 01 Jan 1993.
6. In case any changes are required in the stations & qty nominated, you are requested to forward your recommendations by 30 Oct 92.
