

Please find enclosed a copy of MOCAF&PD letter No.4(7)/2011-PD-I dated 18th July 2011 regarding the cited subject vide which MOCAF&PD has permitted the States/UTs for lifting and distribution of upto six months ration under TPDS in one go, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) There should be no compulsion on the beneficiaries to lift their entitlements of upto six months in one go. To avoid undue financial burden/inconvenience to the beneficiaries, this should be purely voluntary.
- 2) The existing system of lifting the quota every month and in instalments should be permitted to continue for those who are not interested or can not afford to lift the entire quantity.
- 3) Adequate publicity should be made about the same. The bulk distribution of foodgrains may be made as far as possible in the presence of State Government officials, representatives of PRIs, members of Vigilance Committees in Gram Sabha, NGOs concerned, etc. to ensure transparency.

It is requested that necessary arrangement may be made to ensure sufficient supply of foodgrains to meet out the requirement of the State/UT Govts. in lifting six months ration under TPDS in one go.
