Kindly refer to the communication cited above.

Ministry of CAF&PD vide its letter dated 26.03.2015, cited above, has conveyed the decision of the Government for continuation of open market sale of wheat in domestic market under the existing terms and conditions subject to the following modifications:

(i) The sale of wheat under the scheme will be continued after 31.03.2015 only in non-wheat procuring States i.e. excluding Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Gujrat, Maharashtra, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, NCT Delhi UT of Chandigarh.

(ii) The reserve price of wheat in the non procuring States after 31.03.2015 shall be 50/- per quintal plus rail freight ex-Ludhiana to the nearest rail head and transport charges from such rail head to the concerned depot of FCI, from which the sale is to be effected, as was followed for sale under OMSS(D) in 2014-15.

The existing system of issuing notice of e-auction for sale of wheat on every Monday and conducting auction on every Thursday will continue till further orders in all States/UTs except Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, NCT Delhi and UT of Chandigarh. The notice for 1st e-auction during 2015-16 shall be issued by the concerned Regional Offices on 06.04.2015 and e-auction shall be conducted on 09.04.2015.

You are requested to modify the MTF accordingly.

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the competent authority with regard to continuation of open market sale of wheat in domestic market under the existing terms and conditions subject to following specific modifications:

- (i) The sale of wheat under the scheme will be continued after 31.03.2015 only in non-wheat procuring States i.e. States excluding Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, NCT Delhi and UT of Chandigarh
- (ii) The reserve price for sale of wheat in the above said States after 31.03.2015 shall be Rs.1550 per quintal plus the freight charges and road transportation charges, if any, ex-Ludhiana to the concerned depot of FCI, from which the sale is to be effected.
- (iii) The sale through dedicated movement in 2015-16 will be started only when a decision is taken to start the sale of wheat from surplus procuring States namely; Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh.

Kindly refer to the communication cited above.


1) Ministry of CAF&PD vide its letter dated 28.05.2015, cited above, has conveyed policy for sale of wheat to Bulk Consumers under OMSS(D) through e-auction from FCI godowns during 2015-16 till March 2016 (Copy Enclosed).

- 2) The Reserve Price of wheat will be Rs.1550/- per quintal including for URS wheat procured in the current season, which is required to be **disposed of on priority.**
- 3) The notice of e-auction will be issued on every Monday and e-auction will be conducted on every Thursday commencing from 01.06.2015 in Punjab and Haryana.
- 4) E-auction of wheat in other wheat procuring States will commence from 6th July 2015.
- 5) The State/UT-wise quantity to be put in every e-auction shall continue to be the same, as done in 2014-15.
- 6) The quantity approved for sale in an e-auction shall be replenished to that extent by the concerned GM(Region) for next e-auction.
- 7) While selecting depots for offering wheat under e-auction, GM(Punjab/Haryana) shall follow instructions issued by QC Division FCI Hqrs from time to time.
- 8) The State Governments/UT Administrations may also be allowed to participate in the e-auction, if they require wheat outside TPDS & OWS on the same terms.
- 9) GM(Punjab/Haryana) should cause wide publicity to the scheme by giving Advertisement and Press release.
- 10) GM(Punjab/Haryana) are requested to issue notice for e-auction positively on 01.06.2015 without fail. Other GMs(Region) are to be in readiness with all the calculation in order to issue notice for e-auction positively during 6th July 2015 without fail.
- 11) Concerned GMs(Region) shall calculate Railway freight from Ludhiana to the nearest Railhead and road transportation cost from such railhead to the depot and the same will be added to the Reserve Price while calculating sale price. The above calculation may also be uploaded on the FCI website and ensured for uploading on the website of NCDEX-NSPOT.
- 12) EDs(Zone)/GMs(Region) are requested to inform sale progress on weekly basis through e-mail to be sent to gmsales.fci@nic.in and edsales.fci@nic.in.

13) All the other guidelines and instructions issued earlier for OMSS(D) including Dedicated Movement will remain unchanged.

14) Existing MTF, as modified from time to time will be utilized for sale of wheat under OMSS(D).

**Subject: Framing Policy for Open Market Sale Scheme for RMS
2015-16 - regarding.**

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the competent authority on policy for Open Market Sale Scheme for RMS 2015-16 as follows :-


1. Besides continuing sale of wheat in non-wheat producing States, which started in April, 2015, FCI will take action to liquidate surplus stock of wheat from its depots located in Punjab and Haryana during the period of June, 2015 to March, 2016 and in various other States/ UTs during the period of July, 2015 to March, 2016 after re-assessing the quantum of surplus available for sale in the beginning of each quarter. The mode of sale will be same as adopted for Open Market Sale of Wheat in 2014-15 i.e. sale will also be undertaken on dedicated movement basis from the depots of FCI in Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh.

2. For sale of wheat as above, the reserve price of wheat will be kept as Rs.1550 per quintal and in the States/ UTs, other than Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh, the railway freight from Ludhiana to the nearest railhead and road transportation cost from such railhead to the depot from which the sale is effected should be added in the reserve price. Same reserve price may be kept for sale of URS wheat procured in the current season, which is required to be disposed of on priority.

3. Till the facilities for inducting sufficient quantity of wheat for sale in Jammu & Kashmir improve, a special arrangement may be allowed to sell wheat to the buyers of J&K from Punjab on dedicated movement basis (by road) at a reserve price of Rs.1550 per quintal inclusive of CST, which would actually mean that the reserve price will be fixed as Rs.1519.60 per quintal and there will be CST of Rs.30.40 @ 2% thereon.

4. FCI is authorized to decide about the frequency of the auction wheat or rice in various States/ UTs depending on the demand. However, in major wheat surplus States, i.e. Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh, FCI will ensure conduct of weekly e-auctions for sale of wheat.

Subject: Sale of Raw Rice Grade 'A' over and above buffer norms under OMSS (D) – reg.

Ref: 1. This office letter No. J. 1(1)/ 2014/ OMSS (D)/B C/ S.III/Vol.IV dated 25.07.2014.
2. This office letter No. J. 1(1)/ 2014/ OMSS (D)/B C/ Ded. Movt./S.III dated 01.08.2014.

Sir,

DFPD vide OM No.1-4/2014-Py-IV(Pt.) dated 13th March, 2015 has directed FCI to sell surplus quantity of Grade "A" rice available under Central Pool over and above the buffer norms at the end of each quarter during 2015-16 (copy enclosed) under following conditions:-

(a) Rice under OMSS (D) is to be sold through weekly e-auction as done in the case of wheat.

The traders/bulk buyers shall be allowed to participate in the e-auction as in the case of wheat.

- (c) The procedure for empanelment/registration shall be similar to the empanelment/registration process of wheat.
- (d) The minimum and maximum quantity shall be 50 MT and 3500 MT respectively.
- (e) State Govt. or its agencies may also be allowed to participate in the e-auction on the same terms and conditions as applicable in case of sale of wheat under OMSS(D). The maximum quantity allowed to be purchased by the State Govt./State Govt. Agencies in one tender shall be 15,000 MT.
- (f) The uniform reserve price of Grade "A" rice for a e-auction is Rs.2300/- per quintal plus applicable taxes.

2. The sale of surplus quantity of Grade "A" rice will be through e-auction carried out by Service Provider appointed by FCI i.e. NCDEX Spot Exchange Ltd. on electronic platform as being done in case of wheat.

3. GMs (Region) shall give wide publicity to the scheme by giving advertisements in one National Daily and one Regional Daily having wide circulation in State / UT besides issuing press release, informing the local chamber of commerce, the Rice Millers Associations in the state and hosting the same on FCI Website and service provider website informing the prospective buyers about

- i) Sale of Raw Rice Grade "A" under OMSS(D) through e-auction on the e-platform of NCDEX.
- ii) Empanelment of buyers on continuous basis.
- iii) Details of website of FCI, Regional Office and service provider.
- iv) Toll-free number of service provider (1800210222) for any query.

4. The raw rice Grade "A" will be sold only to the empanelled buyers.

5. The Service Provider shall empanel the bulk consumers/traders on the basis of following documents after due verification. The process of empanelment is to be completed within two days of receipt of the application along with following documents:-

- (i) An attested copy of the current VAT/Trade Tax Registration.
- (ii) An attested copy of PAN issued by Income Tax Department.

i) Attested copies of the latest Annual balance sheet and profit & loss account duly audited by a chartered accountant. In case of newly established firm or the existing firms which have recently started to deal in the business of rice, a provisional Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account for a quarter/Half year accompanied by a limited review by Auditor/Chartered accountant should be furnished. The Balance Sheet/Profit & Loss Account shall also evidence that the firm is dealing in the business of rice, failing which the firms shall submit copy of VAT returns/Annual Report by way of additional documents, to evidence that the firm is dealing in the business of rice.

(iv) An Undertaking on a stamp paper of Rs. 100/- that the rice so purchased from FCI under OMSS (D) will be utilized domestically and will not be exported by the bidder.

6. You are again requested to give wide publicity and to hold meetings with the rice traders in your region in order to inform them about the scheme and encourage them to participate in e-auction of Raw Rice Grade "A" under OMSS(D). Outcomes of the meeting may be intimated to FCIHqrs.

7. Detailed instructions and MTF will follow. All the GMs(Region) in the meanwhile are to be in a state of readiness for immediate issuance of notice of e-auction on receipt of MTF and guidelines from FCIHqrs. Regional office shall properly co-ordinate with NCDEX for ensuring smooth sale of Raw Rice Grade "A" under OMSS(D).

Kindly refer to the communications cited.

2) MOCAF&PD vide OM No.1-4/2014-Py-IV(Pt.) dated 20 March, 2015 (Ref.4) has directed FCI to sell surplus quantity of Grade "A" rice available under Central Pool over and above the buffer norms at the beginning of each quarter during 2015-16.

3) Accordingly, decision has been taken to undertake sale of Raw Grade-A rice at the Reserve price of Rs.2300/- per quintal plus applicable taxes. GMs(Region) shall intimate the State/UT-wise applicable taxes to NCDEX in order to enable them to calculate and collect correct sale proceed. Broad instructions in the matter have already been communicated vide letter of even number dated 19.03.2015 with the request to be in the state of readiness for conducting e-auction.

4) In this regard State/UT-wise weekly quantity of Raw rice Grade-A to be offered is at Annexure-A. The quantity approved for sale in e-auction shall be replenished to that extent by concerned GM(Region) for next e-auction.

5) It has also been decided that 1st e-auction will be conducted on 9th April 2015 and the notice for the same will be published on 6th April 2015. Thereafter, the notice of e-auction will be issued on every Monday and e-auction will be conducted on every Thursday.

6) While selecting depots for offering Raw Grade-A rice under e-auction, GM(Region) shall follow instructions contained in HQrs QC Division Circular No.1 of 2014 dated 13.03.2014, enclosed guidelines, and other instructions in vogue/issued from time to time.

7) The State Governments/UT Administrations may also be allowed to participate in the e-auction, if they require Raw Grade-A rice outside TPDS/NFSA and OWS on the terms similar to sale of wheat.

8) All GMs(Region) should cause wide publicity to the scheme by giving Advertisement and Press release.

9) EDs(Zone)/GMs(Region) are requested to inform sale progress on weekly basis through email to be sent to gmsales.fci@nic.in and edsales.fci@nic.in.


