Sub: Request for relaxation in Uniform Specifications of wheat for Rabi Marketing Season 2021-22 in Madhya Pradesh -reg.


Sir,

I am directed to refer your letters dated 30.03.2021, 31.03.2021, 06.04.2021 & 20.04.2021 seeking relaxation in Uniform Specifications of wheat for Rabi Marketing Season 2021-22 due to unseasonal rainfall in districts various districts of Madhya Pradesh.

In order to reduce the hardship of farmers and to avoid distress sale of wheat, it has been decided to procure wheat in the below mentioned districts of Madhya Pradesh with the following relaxation in the Uniform Specifications of wheat during the Rabi Marketing Season 2021-22 **with immediate effect.**

- i. Lustre loss wheat containing upto 10% affected kernels shall be purchased without any value cut in 24 districts i.e. **Datia, Mandla, Khandwa, Seoni, Rewa, Chhindwara, Tikamgarh, Niwari, Khargone, Indore, Morena, Shivpur, Sheopur, Guna, Ashoknagar, Bhind, Shajapur, Betul, Sagar, Bhopal, Raisen, Rajgarh, Sehore and Vidisha** of state Madhya Pradesh.
- ii. Wheat so procured shall be stacked and accounted for separately.
- iii. Any deterioration of quality of wheat stock procured under Relaxed Norms during storage shall be the sole responsibility of the State Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- iv. The stock procured under relaxed specification would be consumed in the state itself.

- v. Any financial or operational implications due to this relaxation will be the responsibility of the State Government.
