Subject: Special adhoc/additional allocation of wheat /rice rice for BPL families under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) –reg.

Please refer to the communication cited.

2. Please find enclosed herewith relevant copy of Ministry of CAF&PD letters dated 16th May 2011 (referred) vide which Ministry has communicated its decision to make further special adhoc/additional allocation of wheat and rice for BPL families under TPDS at the BPL Central Issue Price(CIP) for distribution during the current financial year. The validity for deposit of the cost and lifting of foodgrains will be upto 31.03.2012. The lifting against this allocation is allowed with immediate effect. The details of the allocation are given below.

3. The foodgrains under this allocation shall be lifted from FCI stocks only. DCP States may also ensure that their allocation is lifted from FCI stocks only. It may also be ensured that older stocks are issued first by following 'FIFO' principle at depot level.

4. It is relevant to mention that Hon'ble Supreme Court in a writ petition(Civil) filed by the Peoples Union for Civil Liberties has directed to all the States Governments/Union Territories to forthwith exhaust the existing quantity which has been allocated to them. The Chief Secretaries of all the States/Union Territories were also directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to ensure that the food grains allocated to the States/UTs are lifted and distributed immediately. Therefore concerned Food Secretaries may be approached to lift the foodgrains expeditiously and completely. The State/UT s Government may also be advised to ensure that atleast 50% of the allocation is lifted by October 2011. ED (Zone) may conduct a monthly review of lifting and write a D.O. letter to concerned Food Secretary about the progress of lifting.

5. Under IISFM/DISFM, data feeding/reporting of allocation/offtake by the States/UTs against this special adhoc/additional allocation should be made in the **TPDS Group (BPL ADDITIONAL)**. In TPDS Group, there is a provision for feeding monthly allocations, but the aforesaid allocation is a lump-sum allocation. Therefore, for making data entry in IISFM/DISFM, the monthly allocation of the concerned State/UT may be entered by dividing total allocation by 10 (June 2011 to March 2012). However, there will be no restriction on the maximum and minimum quantity to be lifted by the State/UT Governments in a month.

6. In this regard, you are requested to issue necessary instructions to all concerned for releasing the stocks as per the instructions contained in the Ministry's allocation order and to ensure adequate and timely availability of stocks in your region to meet the above requirement.
