MESSAGE



You could have come across, or know about instances of irregularities or acts of corruption happening around you in the organisation, but might have remained silent due to fear of victimisation by your colleagues or senior officers. Remaining silent on acts of corruption despite being aware of such acts around will be detrimental to the organisation and would ultimately hit poor people the most. Hence it is imperative on the part of each employee, particularly the youth to proactively make disclosures about improper activities in the organisation.

To instil confidence among our officials to report such activities without any fear FCI has formulated its Whistle Blower policy dated 12.12.2022. The policy is available on FCI-HRMS and the website (fci.gov.in). The complaints should be addressed to General Manager (Vigilance), FCI, Headquarters (16-20, Barakhamba Lane, New Delhi-110001)(Phone:011-43527441). The policy provides an opportunity to employees for making disclosures about the irregularities to the management directly and also ensures confidentiality and protection for the whistle blowers.

I request officers/ officials of the corporation to utilise the opportunity provided by the policy and make disclosures about improper activities which are in their knowledge without any fear for improving the working culture of the organisation and help the organisation to fight corruption.
