Subject: Relaxation in the Uniform Specifications of Paddy and Rice for Kharif Marketing Season
2014 - 15 in respect of Andhra Pradesh – regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. PI(1)/2524/2014 dated 15.12.2014 on the subject
cited above and to state that based on the report of the joint team of officers from State
Government, FCI and this Department, analysis results of jointly collected paddy & resultant rice
samples, request of State Govt. and recommendation of FCI, Government has allowed following
relaxations in the specifications of raw rice in Srikakulam and Vizianagram districts of Andhra
Pradesh for KMS 2014-15 :-

Rice: The percentage of broken grains in raw rice is relaxed upto 30% against the existing limit of
25% in raw rice at the rate of half value cut for CMR as well as levy rice.

The relaxation will be subject to the State Government utilizing the milled rice on
overriding priority for TPDS and Other Welfare Schemes within the State.

Separate account should be maintained by the FCI and the State Government for the rice
procured under uniform specification and under relaxed specifications. The above relaxations shall
be operative with immediate effect and applicable for KMS 2014-15 for Kharif crop only.
