Subject: Relaxation in Uniform Specifications of Paddy for kharif crop (Kharif Marketing Season 2009-10 in Tamil Nadu - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. **25960/B1/2009-I, dated 10.11.2009** seeking relaxation in specification of Paddy for Kharif Marketing Season 2009-10 in respect of Tamil Nadu.

- 2. In order to reduce hardship of farmers and to avoid distress sale of paddy, Government has allowed relaxation in the uniform specifications of paddy during Kharif Marketing Season 2009-10 upto 20% in respect of moisture content against the existing limit of 17% in Thanjavur, Thiruvarur & Nagapattinam districts of Tamil Nadu with **full value cut**.
- These relaxations will be applicable for current Kharif crop only.
- 4. Separate account will be maintained for such paddy/rice milled therefrom.
- 5. The State Government will utilise the milled rice from such paddy only for TPDS/Other Welfare Schemes within the State on over-riding priority.
- 6. The above relaxation will be in operation with immediate effect.
